The Santa Cruz County Association of Realtors Housing Foundation is a local, non-profit organization focused on providing funds to help low income individuals and families become homeowners through our Closing Costs Grants Programs. These programs are for buyers purchasing a primary residence in Santa Cruz County.

What are they?

- Closing costs: Currently \$2,500 for the purchase of a single-family residence, condo, townhome or for the purchase of a manufactured/mobile home (in a park acceptable only if the buyer will own a share in the park in which they are purchasing)
- Community Heroes: An additional grant, currently \$2,500 for buyers who qualify for the Closing Costs Grant and are employed as first responders. Including, but not limited to Police, Firefighters, EMT's, and Military/Veterans.

Who can apply?

- Buyer must meet income limits based on family size, as follows:

Family size	Maximum annual income
1	≤ \$92,500
2	≤ \$105,700
3	≤ \$118,900
4	≤ \$132,100
5	≤ \$142,700
6	≤ \$153,250

- Buyer must live or work in Santa Cruz County.
- Buyer cannot have owned any real property at any location for the 3 years prior to close of escrow on the purchase.
- Buyer must be in escrow to purchase.

How can I get started?

- If you're a first-time buyer that fits the above criteria, ask your local Realtor or Lender to help you with the application.
